Esmeralda was 2nd lady at the Winter Sun, Suzie won the Masters, and Mackennea was 11th overall and 1st in the 18 age group. Cheryl is really improving after having a child earlier this year. Good turn out ladies.

Lots of good age group times on the men's side also led by Ted and Levi's run for second and the masters win, Levi won the Masters at the Winter Sun. Jan Frisby was "on a training run, but someone shot a gun" and he broke Warren Bystedt's 39:03 age group record set at age 74. Jan is running well in the National Masters age group races with seconds in the Syracuse (NY) 5K (20:20) and Tulsa 15K (68 min). Also Carl Tenpas just continues to have a lot of fun out there.

It was fun to put on and watch this race this year and not freeze doing so. Also we raised over \$200 in donations for a real good cause. Thanks to all and have a great 2015.
